I was named to the Pro Bono Honor Roll by Nevada Lawyer magazine, and have done significant pro bono work as a CAP attorney, protecting the rights of children in the legal system.

I'm not here to advance any political aspirations; I have no agenda myself, and no interest in any career as a politician or staffer. The sole reason I am here is to ensure that our party is able to adapt to a changing world so that we can bring in new generations of people who care about our state and our country, and be a party that represents our members, and our communities.

My vision of what our party must do is two-fold: we must be the party that sees how to make things better, and commits to doing so, and we must be realistic enough to see the best means to accomplish that. This means that if something is important to the well-being of this country, we can't shy away from it because it is difficult; we must simply focus on how it can be accomplished within the realities of the situation.

Every day I work with the laws passed by our politicians, trying to make them serve the people of Nevada, but those laws don't always do what they're supposed to do. I know firsthand how subtle changes in legislation and policy can have significant real-world effects, and I want to help fight to ensure that Nevada's laws and lawmakers are the best for the people of Nevada.

Our greatest challenges right now are improving our state, ensuring we do our part to get Donald Trump out of the White House, and healing the wounds that divided our
