2020 Elector Nomination Form

Deadlines and Process

I. Presidential Electors

- a. Nevada will select six (6) persons to serve as Presidential Electors for the 2020 Presidential election.
- b. Each congressional district caucus will elect 1 elector by a majority vote of all delegates voting in that district.
- c. The state convention will elect 2 electors by a majority vote of all delegates voting.
- d. Individuals may run for elector statewide or in their district, but not both.
- e. Candidates for the position of elector must file a statement of candidacy to the chair of the rules and nominations committee at filing@nvdeems.com by **10:00 a.m. on Friday, May 29, 2020.**
- f. Each candidate for the position of elector must file, along with their statement of candidacy, a signed statement of support for the Democratic Party. The statement of support will include a disqualifier clause that will prevent the elector, if elected, from serving in the instance that they are no longer a registered Democrat on the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December 2020.

Elections:

- I. Elections shall be conducted pursuant to the Rules of the 2020 Nevada State Democratic Convention.
- II. The election of Electors will occur June 13, 2020 through a remote voting process using secure Google Forms.
