ELECTED CHAIR OF THE NEVADA STATE DEMOCRATIC PARTY

IN 1990, I was elected Chair of the Nevada State Democratic Party. During my tenure, we created the first coordinated campaign. Under my leadership at the state party, we turned Nevada blue for the first time in over 30 years.



CHAMPIONED PROGRESSIVE POLICIES IN THE ASSEMBLY + SENATE

IN 2008, I was elected to the Nevada State Assembly. In 2012, I was elected to the Nevada State Senate. There, I fought for a living wage, workers' rights and criminal justice reform. I succeeded in passing significant progressive policies, but my experience with a Republican governor highlighted the need for Democratic leadership at every level of state government. If we want to continue passing progressive legislation, we must protect our elected Democrats.



FOUGHT FOR REPRESENTATION + NV FAMILIES AS COMMISSIONER

IN 2018, I was elected to the Clark County Commission, where I have advocated for issues of social and economic justice. As a Commissioner, I spearheaded the creation of Indigenous People's Day in Nevada, I revitalized Clark County's Asian-American commission and I worked to aid Nevada families impacted by the pandemic, expanding rental and food assistance efforts.

I will fight to elect Democrats from our school boards to the Governor's mansion. As a Nevada co-chair for Bernie 2020, I saw how a multiethnic, multigenerational movement can change the face of politics. That's exactly the type of movement Democrats need to mobilize to win again in 2022.
