

Nevada Democrats' Delegate Selection Overview

In February 2024, Nevada Democrats will begin our process to elect delegates to the Democratic National Convention. Delegates to the national convention play a critical role in our party – at the convention, delegates will determine the Democratic nominee for President and adopt the national party platform.

Nevada will have 48 delegates at the national convention in 2024. Elected delegates are chosen through our three step delegate selection process.

Three Step Process to Become National Delegate



Presidential Preference Primary – Tuesday, February 6

Nevada Democrats' delegate selection process begins with the Presidential Preference Primary (Primary) on Tuesday, February 6. There are three easy ways to participate:

- All registered Democrats will receive a vote-by-mail ballot, which they can return in the mail or at any voting center in their county.
- They can also vote in person at any voting center in their county during the early voting period between January 27 and February 2.
- And, they can cast their ballots at any voting center in their county on Primary Day.

Any eligible voter may register or update their party preference by the deadline for standard registration on January 9 and still receive a vote-by-mail ballot. Voters may also register in person or online between January 24 and February 6. However, they aren't able to vote by mail.

Assembly District Delegate Election Meetings (DEMs) – Saturday, April 13

The next step of the process is Assembly District DEMs, which will take place on Saturday, April 13. At DEMs, eligible Democrats will elect delegates to the state convention, the final step of the delegate election process.



DEMs are open to any registered Democrat who lives in the Assembly District and voted in the Primary. Eligible Democrats will be able to register to attend no later than March 14. DEMs will be led by Temporary Chairs recruited by the state party.

State Convention – Saturday, May 18

The state party will host the state convention on Saturday, May 18. This is the final step of the process where delegates to the state convention will choose delegates to the national convention.

Nevada Democrats will have 48 delegates to the national convention, including:

- 23 congressional district-level delegates
- 12 automatic party leader and elected official delegates (PLEOs)
- 5 pledged PLEOs
- 8 at-large delegates

To run to become a national delegate, candidates must have participated in the Primary, attended a DEM, and been elected a delegate to the state convention. They must also submit an intent form by May 18. Forms will be available on the state party website and in person at the state convention. All delegates except automatic PLEOs will be chosen at the state convention.
